Introducing Key Speaker: Roberto de Philippis

Roberto de Philippis (D.Chem, MsC) is Professor of Microbial Biotechnology at the Department of Agricultural Biotechnology, the University of Florence. He is also President Elect of the International society of Applied Phycology.

His main area of research concerns the physiology and biochemistry of photosynthetic bacteria. He has published more than 180 scientific papers (mainly on international peer reviewed journals), ten chapters in books and has participated in more than 90 international and national congresses.


